The Grants Strategist position will work closely with Lead Strategists to manage all stages of the Grants Development process for several clients - from initial introduction proposals to grant writing through cultivation. Bambu currently manages grants programs for fifteen nonprofits and this position will be responsible to manage three of those clients' grants programs completely. You will be responsible to manage monthly planning calls for the three clients you will be managing (planning calls are ~1hr). You must be available during the weekdays for these calls.
